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OUR VISION

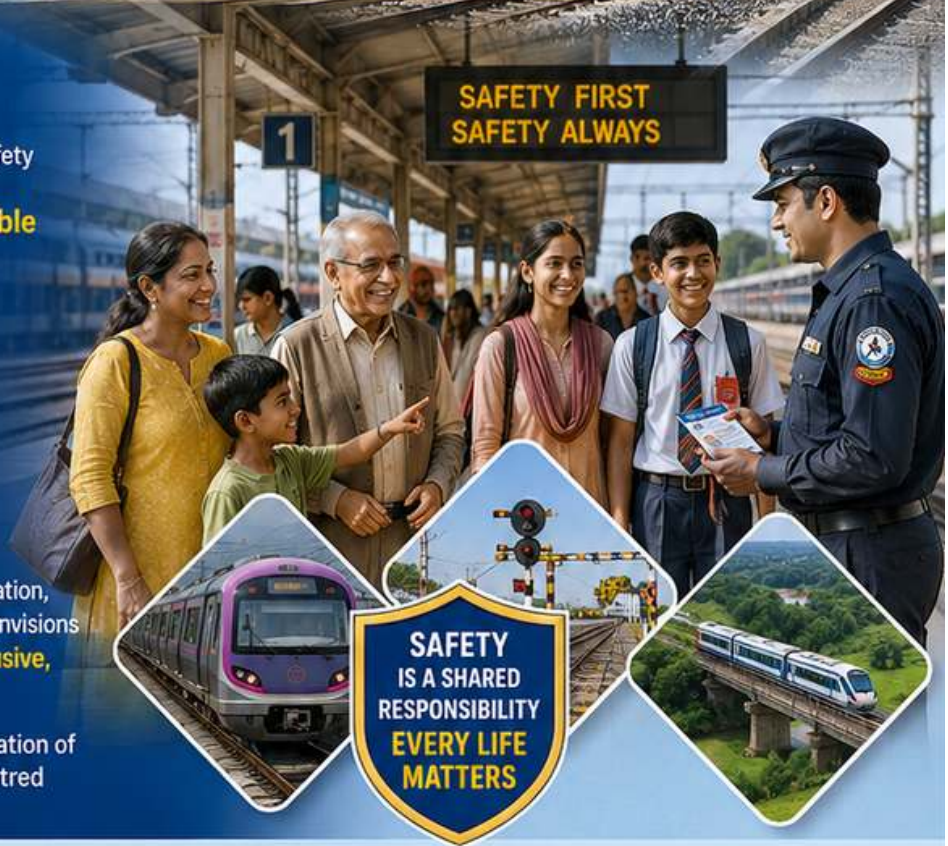
The vision of the National Railway Safety Awareness Mission is to help build a

safety-conscious, informed and responsible railway society in which every individual understands railway risks, follows authorised safety procedures and actively contributes to preventing accidents.

The Mission aspires to support the development of a railway culture where safety becomes an everyday value, responsible conduct becomes a public habit and the **protection of life remains the highest priority**.

Through sustained awareness, education, communication, research and stakeholder participation, the Mission envisions railway and metro journeys that are **safer, more inclusive, more accessible and more resilient**.

It seeks to contribute to the broader national aspiration of creating safe, smart, sustainable and people-centred mobility systems for **Viksit Bharat 2047**.



MISSION PURPOSE

The principal purpose of the Mission is to **transform railway-safety knowledge into responsible public behaviour**.

It aims to simplify important safety information and communicate it through accessible, multilingual and community-friendly formats. Special emphasis is placed on preventing track trespassing, unsafe crossing practices, platform-related accidents, unauthorised travel, careless boarding or alighting, electrical accidents, unsafe photography and other risk-taking behaviour near railway and metro systems.

The Mission also promotes **preparedness for emergencies** by encouraging passengers to remain calm, follow authorised instructions, use emergency facilities responsibly and report hazards through appropriate channels.

Through education and behavioural communication, it seeks to reduce preventable risks while **strengthening public confidence** in safe railway travel.

1 PASSENGER SAFETY AND RESPONSIBLE TRAVEL



- Arrive in time, use authorised entrances and crossings
- Stay behind platform safety lines, supervise children and elders
- Do not board or alight from moving trains
- Do not lean out of doors/windows or travel on footboards
- Protect belongings and follow announcements



2 PREVENTION OF TRACK TRESPASSING



- Tracks are not for walking, shortcuts or photography
- Trains can approach rapidly and silently
- Use foot overbridges, subways and authorised crossings
- Parents, schools and communities—discourage unsafe practices



3 LEVEL-CROSSING AND ROAD-USER SAFETY



- Respect warning signals, barriers and signage
- Do not cross after warning activation or closed barrier
- Be patient, stay alert and follow instructions
- Drivers, cyclists and pedestrians—your discipline saves lives



4 STATION AND PLATFORM SAFETY



- Avoid overcrowding, pushing and running on platforms
- Stay away from platform edges
- Handle luggage responsibly; keep pathways and exits clear
- Cooperate during peak periods, festivals and emergencies



5 ELECTRICAL SAFETY



- Never climb coaches, locomotives, poles or electrical structures
- Do not throw objects on overhead wires
- Avoid kite flying, drones or activities near electrical lines
- Report fallen wires, damage or suspicious conditions immediately



6 SAFETY EDUCATION FOR STUDENTS AND YOUNG CITIZENS



- Learn safe behaviour around trains, tracks, stations and level crossings
- Participate in workshops, competitions and outreach
- Share safety messages with family, friends and community
- Never be exposed to hazardous railway locations or duties



7 RAILWAY-SIDE COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT



- Community meetings, awareness campaigns and local outreach
- Address trespassing, unsafe crossings, waste, livestock movement and other risks
- Work with schools, resident groups and local leaders
- Together, we build safer neighbourhoods



8 EMPLOYEE, CONTRACTOR AND WORKFORCE AWARENESS



- Safety orientation, refresher training and toolbox talks
- Use PPE and follow approved procedures
- Report hazards and near-misses
- Life, safety and procedures come before deadlines



9 METRO AND URBAN-RAIL SAFETY



- Use escalators, lifts and platform-screen doors safely
- Allow passengers to exit before boarding
- Do not obstruct doors or stand near edges
- Offer priority and assistance to those in need



10 DIGITAL SAFETY COMMUNICATION



- Use digital platforms for accurate safety information
- Avoid dangerous photography, challenges and content creation
- No photo or video is worth risking your life
- Be responsible, respectful and safety-focused online



11 EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSIBLE REPORTING



- Stay calm, follow instructions and do not panic
- Know emergency communication and basic first-response
- Do not spread rumours or obstruct responders
- Report hazards and unsafe behaviour through official channels

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RESEARCH, INNOVATION AND KNOWLEDGE DEVELOPMENT
